To add 2-digit numbers, follow these steps:

1. Add the ones.

$$\begin{array}{r|l} \text{T} & \text{O} \\ 2 & 7 \\ + & 3 \ 1 \\ \hline & 8 \end{array}$$

2. Add the tens.

$$\begin{array}{r|l} \text{T} & \text{O} \\ 2 & 7 \\ + & 3 \ 1 \\ \hline 5 & 8 \end{array}$$

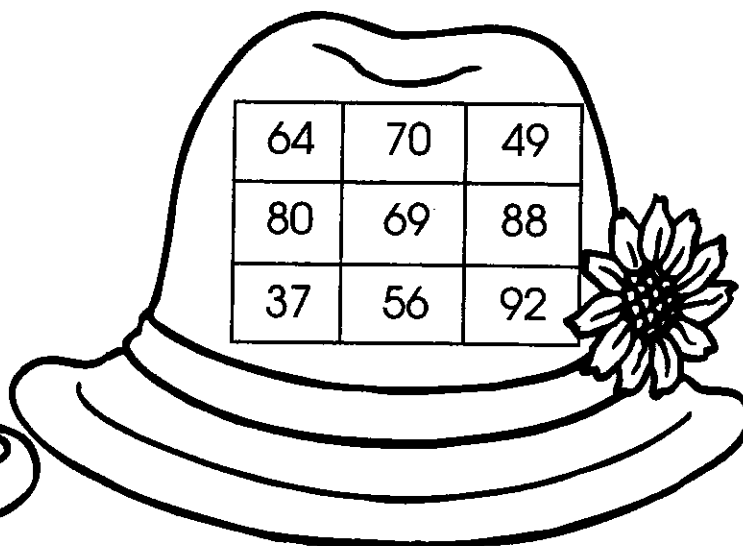
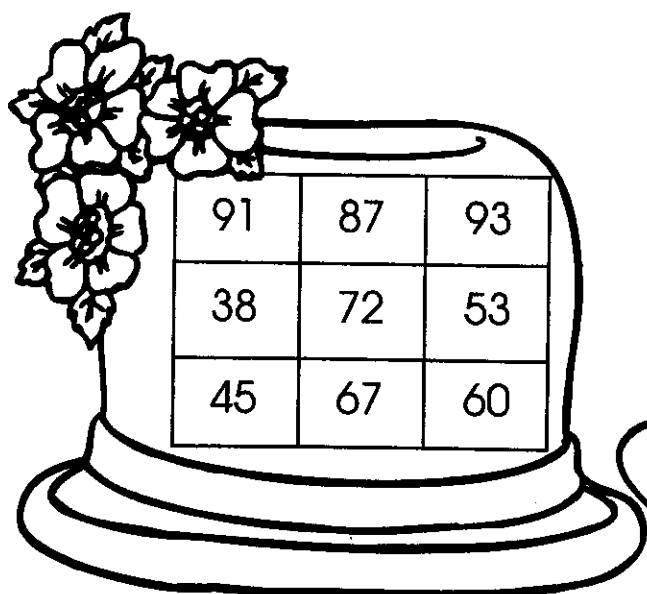


