## Subtracting 2-digit numbers

Unit 5

To subtract from 2-digit numbers, follow these steps:

1. Subtract the ones.

$$\begin{array}{r|l} \text{T} & \text{O} \\ 8 & 9 \\ - & 4 & 2 \\ \hline & 7 \end{array}$$

2. Subtract the tens.

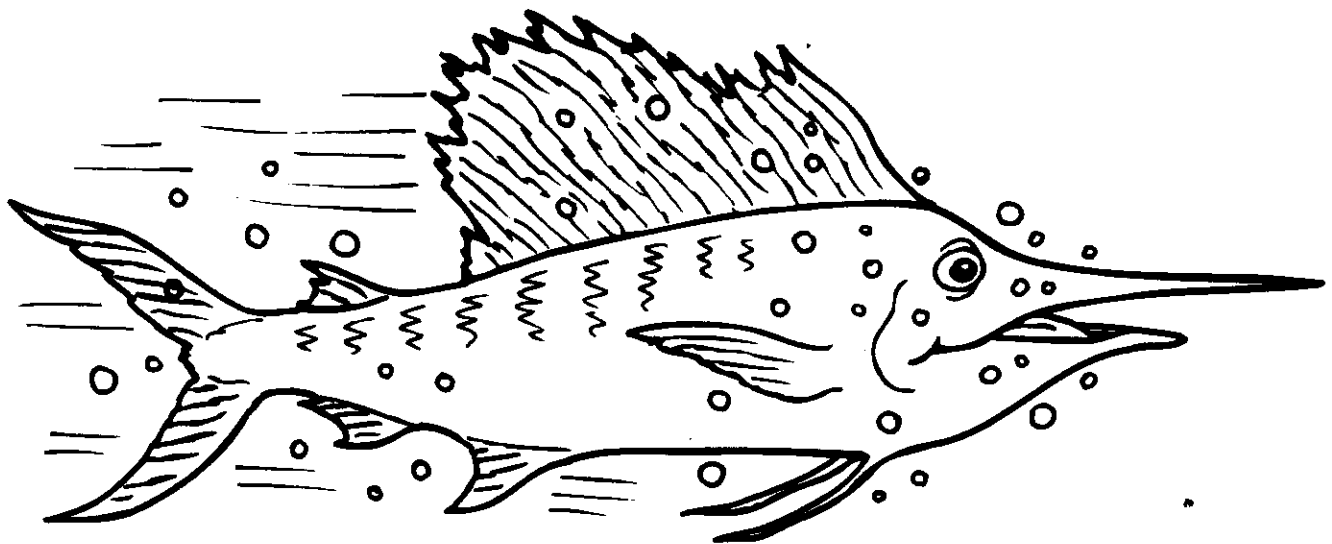
$$\begin{array}{r|l} \text{T} & \text{O} \\ 8 & 9 \\ - & 4 & 2 \\ \hline 4 & 7 \end{array}$$








