Senior Yearbook/Newspaper Info

What do I need to turn in for the yearbook/newspaper?

You need to turn in a Senior Baby Picture, a picture of you when you were less than 1 year old if at all possible. <u>This is optional</u>. If you do not turn one in, one will NOT be included for you.

You should also turn in <u>two</u> senior pictures (one for the yearbook and one for the newspaper). It is recommended that they are two <u>different</u> pictures; if you want the same picture for each, then you only need to submit one. All pictures must be appropriate for the yearbook/newspaper. No inappropriate items, clothing, hand signals, weapons, or other subject matter allowed. All pictures must comply with the school code of conduct. Anything regarding illegal references, weapons, or is suggestive will be turned over to the administration. Students must be fully clothed; senior baby pictures where the student appears naked will be denied.

How to submit/turn in?

We have created a website for you to submit these photos electronically to make it easier on everyone. The site/form is very easy to use. Please read and follow the directions carefully. Parents, if you need help, please have your student assist you. Please submit the baby picture, senior yearbook picture, and senior spotlight (newspaper) picture to the following website: https://bit.ly/2Z5VhnH. A link to this site has been provided in the Senior Google Classroom and has been e-mailed to you by Mrs. Bowdler.

If you have trouble with the above website:

We prefer for the baby picture, yearbook picture, and newspaper spotlight picture to be sent in electronically (E-mail abowdler@gosnellschool.net or put them on a CD or jump drive and turn in with this packet). You will get the CD/jump drive back, but it may not be until the yearbook comes out in May. If you turn in printed copies, clearly print your name on the back of all of these pictures and label which you would like to use for each publication. You can also upload your pictures to your Google Drive and share them with Mrs. Bowdler (abowdler@gosnellschool.net) if you prefer.

The photographer(s) who took your senior pictures can also send your photos in through the website above OR e-mail your photos to Mrs. Bowdler at abowdler@gosnellschool.net. We would prefer this because they are better quality since they are in a digital format.

Other Pictures We Are Accepting:

The yearbook staff will also be collecting "Then and Now" pictures. Please feel free to turn in any pictures you have of you <u>and</u> your friends from back "Then" of your elementary, junior high, and early high school days at Gosnell. Please put your name on the back of all pictures that are submitted for this purpose and label them as "then and now." These pictures can also be submitted electronically in the same procedure listed previously (E-mail Mrs. Bowdler at abowdler@gosnellschool.net or put them on a CD or jump drive and turn in with this packet).

As we just mentioned, we will also be featuring pictures from this school year for the "Now" portion of the "Then and Now" page so if you have or take any pictures this school year of you and your fellow senior classmates, please feel free to send those in to us as well in the same procedure mentioned above for the "Then" photos.

When do they need to be turned in?

All of these items (senior baby picture, senior yearbook picture, senior newspaper spotlight picture, and then and now pictures) are due on **September 29, 2020** to Mrs. Bowdler, Room 119. Please return your completed senior spotlight form and parent page form (if you are getting one) in the envelope you received the senior packet materials in.
